Narrative

Incident Description

During the physical return and account cancellation process at the retail showroom, store personnel took physical custody of the equipment along with its original packaging. However, instead of executing the mandatory digital scanning and reverse-inventory protocols to update the billing system, staff intentionally withheld the returned hardware from standard processing. This failure of the retail chain of custody resulted in the physical item being retained inside the facility while corporate billing systems generated ten consecutive months of fraudulent, predatory equipment charges on an account that was completely out of my possession. The evidence indicates that this is a case of deliberate internal retail theft and asset diversion by store personnel. By taking physical possession of the box but failing to log it into corporate inventory, employees isolated the hardware for unauthorized secondary use or personal gain while letting the un-scanned balance default onto my credit profile. To obscure this misconduct during legal proceedings, representatives subsequently introduced manufactured transaction records—including a falsified receipt detailing an unmade cash payment—to distort the store's true inventory ledger.
